

















**Taupo Heat Babich NZ Wide Pairs**

Wednesday 8th July is the start of the Tauhara Handicap Pairs



Don't come to bridge if you are unwell, or have been in close contact with someone who is unwell.

If someone in your family has just returned from overseas we strongly recommend that you don't come to bridge for 14 days after the date of their return.

In particular, because the early symptoms of infection with the coronavirus are the same as a cold, do not come to bridge if you have a cold.

The directors / convenors have the power to send members home if they appear to be unwell.

The coronavirus spreads the same way as the cold viruses spread. By coughs, sneezes, and by touching an object or surface with viral particles on it, and then touching your mouth, nose or eyes.

### Hygiene when playing

Cover your mouth and nose when you cough or sneeze, or you can cough or sneeze into your sleeve

If you are worried about contamination wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, or use the hand - sanitizer.
